We are a team of five uniformed officers who do foot patrol in pairs within the three Business Improvement Districts (BIDs) attending a variety of calls for services ranging in scope from:

- Addictions
- Minor Disturbances;
- Individuals requiring access to shelter and/or nutrition;
- Suspicious persons & loitering;
- Individuals exhibiting behaviours typical to those dealing with mental illness;
- Providing directions and business information;
- Facilitate partnerships with local businesses, residents and community support organizations in order to identify potential issues and areas of concern;
- Person injured or in need of ambulance/medical attention where it is not a result of criminal conduct;
- Attend special events and functions in the 3 BIDs (community involvement).
